The Bonerowski Palace is housed in a historic townhouse dating back to the end of the 13th century.

The common name comes from Boner, a noble family who played an important role in the Jagiellonian court. The townhouse has been reconstructed several times, partly complementing the original Gothic style of the Renaissance and Baroque elements. In 1836 a front elevation was rebuilt, and in the mid-nineteenth century a number of changes were made to enlarge the building without interfering with the coherence of its styling, making the building an eclectic, historic character.

The unique building of The Bonerowski Palace to this day is one of the most beautiful monuments of mixed architecture of old Krakow. Archaeologists have identified significant architectural treasures in it, such as the medieval pillar cut into a Gothic way or depicting rural scenes in polychrome, a magnificent 17th century specimen.

In this beautiful place, in the magical surroundings of old Cracow, is the luxurious The Bonerowski Palace, a place where history and spirit of several epochs are interwoven with the modern technologies, comfort and cuisine of the world.
