

## PORT LINCOLN and EYRE PENINSULA

**2021 DEPARTURE DATE:** TUESDAY 20 APRIL

- Adventure Bay Charters 'Seafood Water to Wharf' tour including seafood tasting, Boston Bay cruise and afternoon tea.
- Stunning Silo Art at Tumby Bay, National Trust Tumby Bay Museum. 'Patches at the Bay.'
- Stunning rugged coastal scenery, magnificent cliffs, secluded coves and bays.

### NOTES:

**Health and Fitness:** To assist us when booking, please advise your King William Travel consultant if you have any special needs such as mobility, dietary etc. A minimum level of fitness is required in order to be able to participate. You will need to be able to walk up a flight of stairs and manage coach steps unaided and you must inform us before the commencement of the tour of any medical condition which may affect your ability to participate in the tour. If you are unable to manage on your own, it will be necessary to be accompanied by another person who is fit and able to assist you in day to day tasks and capable of providing the assistance required. Dietary requests must be accompanied by the appropriate dietary information.

### HUGHES TRANSFERS FROM AND TO YOUR HOME:

Hughes transfers apply in the zoned area. These transfers may be available at additional cost to passengers who live outside the zoned area - please ask your King William Travel consultant.

Passengers will be contacted by the home transfer operator 'HUGHES HOME PICK UP SERVICE' **two (2) working days** before the commencement of the tour to confirm the time they will be arriving at your home. **If you have missed the call, please contact Hughes 24 hours prior to departure on phone 8440 0766 for your pick up time. If you are resident at a retirement village, please ensure Hughes have clear instructions from you as to means of entry and directions to find your home.**

**Also, if you are out of zone you will be advised of the additional payment due and this should be made direct to the driver on the day of travel.**

Hughes home transfers are based on **4 persons to a car**. (numbers in a vehicle may vary according to type of vehicle used). In order to accommodate 4 persons and their baggage, suitcases should measure no more than **64cms in height** when standing on end. Baggage larger than 64cms will result in a surcharge of **\$10.00 per person in each direction**, payable to the driver on the day of travel.

The Hughes home pick up service only applies to scheduled tour departure and return tour dates. Those passengers wishing to extend their tours will be responsible for their own transfers.

### ABOUT YOUR ACCOMMODATION:

Accommodation for **3 nights** will be at the **4 star Port Lincoln Hotel**, right in the heart of Port Lincoln and overlooking spectacular Boston Bay. Hotel facilities include rooms with balcony and sea view, private facilities, reverse cycle air-conditioning, plasma TV, tea & coffee facilities, phone, free wifi. Other hotel facilities include a guest self-service laundry, Sarin's Restaurant, Sharky's Bar and Foreshore, gym and a delightful open-air swimming pool. The hotel also has Lucky Bart's Goldrush Gaming Room with complimentary tea and coffee.



### ITINERARY:

#### **DAY 1 – TUE. 20 APRIL - ADELAIDE/PORT LINCOLN – AUSTRALIAN ARID LANDS BOTANIC GARDEN**

We depart from **Adelaide Central Bus Station, 85 Franklin Street** at **07.30am**. Our coach will take us via Wild Horse Plains to **Port Wakefield** for a short refreshment stop (own cost), after which we continue on to Port Augusta where we pay a visit to the **Australian Arid Lands Botanic Garden**, established in 1993 to research, conserve and promote Australia's arid zone flora. Enjoy a **light lunch** in the cafe and time will be allowed afterwards to explore the garden. On arrival at **Port Lincoln** we check in to our accommodation at the **4 star Port Lincoln Hotel**, overlooking spectacular Boston Bay and easy walking distance to the main shopping precinct.

## DAY 2 – WED. 21 APRIL - AT PORT LINCOLN – TOWN TOUR, WINE TASTING, COFFIN BAY



Today we enjoy a full day touring **Port Lincoln** and **Coffin Bay**. We are joined by a local guide for a **tour of Port Lincoln** - see the city sights, including the life-size bronze statue of triple Melbourne Cup Winner '**Makybe Diva**', taking pride of place on the foreshore. See the '**Hollywood houses**,' then up **Winter's Hill Lookout** for spectacular coastal panoramas over Port Lincoln, Boston Bay and Whalers Way.

Later we visit **Boston Bay Wines** for a wine tasting then enjoy a **tasty lunch** at the delightful **Swan Sanctuary** at Coomunga. After lunch we head off to nearby **Coffin Bay**, discovered by Matthew Flinders in 1802 and named in honour of his friend Sir Isaac Coffin. There have been many shipwrecks on the rugged exposed coastline which contrasts so sharply with the tranquil and calm waterways within the bays. The coastal scenery is stunning, with magnificent cliffs, secluded coves and bays.

## DAY 3 – THU. 22 APRIL - AT PORT LINCOLN – MORNING ALTERNATIVE ACTIVITIES - 'RUBY AND KATE' OR THE AXEL STENROSS MARITIME MUSEUM – AFTERNOON - 'SEAFOOD WATER TO WHARF TOUR' AND BOSTON BAY CRUISE

This morning there is a choice of activities. Mainly for the ladies, is a visit to **Christina at 'Ruby and Kate**,' Australia's leading online quilting and fabrics store.

Find a wonderful array of beautiful fabrics including designers such as Amy Butler, Kaffe Fassett, Art Gallery, Tilda, Liberty and many more. Alternatively there is a visit to the unique **Axel Stenross**



**Maritime Museum** celebrating the lives of Finnish boatbuilders, the **late Axel Stenross and Frank Laakso**. The museum is centered around the original boat building workshop and features relics and artefacts of the windjammer era including an extensive collection of early maritime photographs.

After a **light lunch** back at the hotel, this afternoon we head off with **Adventure Bay Charters** on the

**'Seafood from Water to Wharf'** tour for an insight into the Port Lincoln fishing industry. Stroll around the marina learning about the fleet which brings home the seafood harvest, visit the **aquariums** to see live product and **taste the fresh produce**. Later cruise out into **Boston Bay** and visit Kingfish, Tuna and Mussel farms to see close up how they work. **Afternoon tea** included.

**DAY 4 – FRI. 23 APRIL - PORT LINCOLN/ADELAIDE VIA TUMBY BAY & SILO ART, NATIONAL TRUST TUMBY BAY MUSEUM, 'PATCHES AT THE BAY' - SPENCER GULF SEAROAD FERRY** is morning after breakfast we take our leave of Port Lincoln and begin our return journey to Adelaide. We head off to the pretty seaside community of Tummy Bay and on the way into town we stop at the stunning **Viterra Tummy Bay Silo Art** of two local boys 'jetty jumping.' This work is by artist Martin Ron and is included in the Australian Silo Art Trail collection. At Tummy Bay we explore the **National Trust Tummy Bay Museum** housed in a circa 1950's pre-fabricated school building with its fascinating memorabilia of the area including shipping, early settlers, historic household items, ships' models and collections of sea shells, just to name a few. There will also be time for a visit for any quilters to '**Patches at the Bay,**' after which we enjoy **lunch** at the **Tummy Bay Hotel**. After lunch we head off to **Lucky Bay** where we join the **Spencer Gulf Searoad ferry** for the 2 hour journey to **Wallaroo**. Refreshments are available for purchase on board. At Wallaroo we reboard our coach for the final leg of our journey to Adelaide with a comfort stop at Port Wakefield. (own cost). Arrive back at **Adelaide Central Bus Station** at **9.00pm**. (B,L)

### TRAVEL INSURANCE:

### EVENTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF KING WILLIAM TRAVEL:

Should an event occur which is beyond the control of King William Travel, ie: delays to ship, aircraft, train, coach thereby incurring extra expenses, these additional costs are borne by the passenger at the time of the event. A travel insurance claim for reimbursement should be submitted to the insurance company upon return home. It should be understood that neither King William Travel nor any subsidiary company or representative shall be liable for any loss, injury or damage arising from our services.

### ITINERARIES:

Itineraries are subject to change and no responsibility can be accepted. Coach operator and size of coach may be changed at the discretion of King William Travel without notice. Where a tour does not meet minimum numbers travelling together on the outward journey a cost surcharge will apply. If group numbers fall below 15 adult paying passengers no tour leader will be provided. No itemisation of tour arrangements can be given and no refund for any portion of a tour not taken. Flora and fauna as described in an itinerary is nature and as such cannot be guaranteed.

### ACCOMMODATION:

King William Travel reserves the right to alter hotel/motel accommodation and to substitute a suitable alternative. Where accommodation is booked on a 'will share basis,' at the time of finalisation if there is nobody suitable to share with, it may be necessary to pay the appropriate single supplement. King William Travel does not accept any responsibility for the non-compatibility of 'sharing' clients. If by choice a single room is requested and booked a single room surcharge will apply.

### HEALTH AND FITNESS:

### FUEL SURCHARGES AND TAXES:

All bookings may attract additional fuel surcharges and taxes which can be levied up to and including the date of departure even if final payment has been made. Booking is subject to final audit.

### SECURITY DEPOSIT:

A non-refundable security deposit of **\$ 690.00 per person (inc GST)** is required within five (5 days) of booking.

### FINAL PAYMENTS:

The security deposit forms part of the total price, the balance of which is due 40 days prior to departure, or in the case of bookings made within that 40 day period, the final payment is due as soon as the booking is confirmed.

### LATE BOOKINGS AND AMENDMENTS:

Bookings made within 7 days inclusive of departure will incur a **late booking fee of \$75.00 per person**. Late bookings subject to availability. Once a booking has been made a **\$75.00 per person amendment fee** will apply for any alterations on selected departures only, and if applicable, one (1) change only to that booking. Transfers to other tours not permitted.

### CREDIT CARDS:

If paying by credit card, a surcharge applies of 2% for Visa and Mastercard and 3.5% for Amex and Diners cards.

### CANCELLATION CONDITIONS:

#### BOOKINGS CANCELLED AFTER THE FINAL PAYMENT HAS BEEN MADE:

- (a) Bookings cancelled 40 days or earlier, full refund less deposit fee and any other non-refundable services or products.
- (b) Bookings cancelled 39 days or less prior to departure will incur a cancellation fee of 100% of the tour cost.
- (c) No refund can be given for any portion of the tour not taken and no refund after the tour has commenced.



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
